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| 9. | <p><b>Requirements to Proceed (BSc Transfer)</b></p> <p><b>To Proceed to Year 4 of the BSc Veterinary Nursing</b><br/>To have achieved an aggregate average of at least 50% from the 3 Transfer assessments (section 5.4).</p> <p>AND<br/>To have met the requirements to be awarded the FdSc as described in section 8.</p> <p>OR<br/>To gain a merit overall from the FdSc award</p> |
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10. **Consequences of Failure, Failure to Complete and No Detriment Safety Net**
- 10.1. A student is required to resit any module (leading to the Foundation degree), failed at the first attempt. In order to resit a student will retake any assessment activity failed at the first attempt.
- 10.2. A student who has achieved a pass in a module is able to opt to have a second attempt at any modular assessment. The highest marked from each assessment will be taken forward to calculate the module mark and overall classification.
- 10.3. The module marks obtained from 10.1 and 10.2 above will be uncapped.
- 10.4. A student who fails to satisfy the requirements for the award of the FdSc VN (section 8.1) after two attempts is required to relinquish the course. They have a right of appeal as described in the Colleg.41 reW904 398.30 G. EMC /P /MCID 18>DC q1 Tm0 G[( )g/F4 11.04
