15.3	For Level 7
15.3.1	A student who fails a Masters (Level 7) module at the first attempt shall have a right to resit. Any module taken for a second time will gain a mark no greater than 50%.
15.3.2	When a module resit involves a piece of assessed work, the amount of time the resit student is given to do that work should be the same as on the first occasion.
15.3.3	A student who has met the requirements for a BSc or BSc (Hons), or an MSci degree may opt to receive the degree after the first sitting. A student who takes this option shall relinquish their right to re-sit for the MSci (Hons) degree.
15.3.4	A student who fails at the second attempt will be required to relinquish the course. They will have a right of appeal as described in College Regulations.
15.3.5	A student who has passed the required Level 6 (Stage 4) modules shall remain eligible for the award of BSc or BSc (Hons).
